



3-19-2024 a regular meeting of the Shellsburg City Council was called to order by Mayor Travis at 6:00pm in the Council Chambers. Roll call was answered by Harvey, Hepker, Travis, Vogt, and Reeves.

Harvey motioned to approve the consent agenda, seconded by Reeves. A roll call vote was taken, all ayes.

Nancy Thorkildson gave a SACG park committee update and mentioned that the council should be receiving resource documents on the downtown walkaround when they become available.

Brody Waters reviewed with the council his desire to install a GaGa Ball Pit in the park. The Council requested he try to get more donations and then bring it back to them at that time.

Nicole Crawford mentioned the traffic and speeding on Jones Street. Sheriff Tippett has advised officers to move around, make traffic stops, and be out in the open.

Ed Callan advised that he will be repainting the Gold Medal sign the week of May 13th. He will need to block off some parking spaces and request notices be put on the city Facebook page and in business windows.

The covenants for the new development were discussed again. Changes are to be made so the resolution can be approved at the next meeting.

Vogt motioned to approve Pay Estimate #2, Water Extension to Wildcat Estates, seconded by Reeves. A roll call vote was taken, all ayes.

Harvey motioned to approve Pay Estimate #2, Sewer Extension to Wildcat Estates, seconded by Hepker. A roll call vote was taken, all ayes.

Travis motioned to approve Resolution #03-19-2024B, to contract with Impact 7G for a PV Feasibility Assessment. Hepker seconded. A roll call vote was taken, all ayes.

Council Forum: Pete's garage is not currently for sale, all new development underground work completed, Citywide Garage Sale May 3rd so request clean up day for May 11th or 18th.

Seeding of the parks put off until fall.

Harvey motioned to approve Resolution #03-19-2024, to contract with SimpleSky for a cybersecurity bundle. Reeves seconded. A roll call vote was taken, all ayes.

Hepker motioned to approve Resolution #03-19-2024A, contracting with ECICOG for nuisance enforcement services. Travis seconded. A roll call vote was taken, all ayes.

Three sidewalks were selected requesting repairs, letters to be sent. Have the attorney draw up sidewalk ordinance. The application fee and permit fee will be waived for the three selected. The tripping hazards need to be fixed.

Vogt motioned to adjourn, seconded by Travis. All ayes.
