September revenues were reviewed and are as follows: General \$8,708.17; Library \$349.07; RUT \$15,989.57; Employee Benefits \$871.99; Emergency Fund \$222.77; LOST \$8,058.99; TIF \$40,883.69; Debt Service \$9,571.44; Water \$22,259.80; Sewer \$30,104.81; Garbage \$16,178.25.

We are still working on trying to get some funding from FEMA less the City and State share.
