



2-18-2025 a regular meeting of the Shellsburg City Council was called to order by Mayor Travis at 6:00pm in the Council Chambers. Roll call was answered by Harvey, Travis, Vogt, and Reeves. Hepker was absent.

Harvey motioned to approve the consent agenda seconded by Reeves. A roll call vote was taken, all ayes.

Vogt motioned to approve the December Treasurer's Report seconded by Reeves. A roll call vote was taken, all ayes. Hepker was absent.

Harvey motioned to approve the December Revenue's seconded by Travis. A roll call vote was taken, all ayes. The December revenues were as follows: General \$12,554.33; Library \$1,321.56; Road Use \$11,496.99; Employee Benefits \$2,011.49; LOST \$7,461.88; TIF \$1,839.44; Debt Service \$3,574.83; Capital Projects \$80,000.01; Water \$13,775.54; Sewer \$24,782.77; Garbage \$12,026.31.

Vogt motioned to approve Resolution #02-18-2025, Authorizing the Shellsburg Rec Department to open a checking account for purposes of collecting online registration fees. A roll call vote was taken, all ayes. Hepker absent. The clerk is to check on minimum balance without fees.

Fish requested the park to be reserved for the SACG Easter Egg Hunt on April 12<sup>th</sup>, 2025 at 10:00am.

As discussed previously, the City will be keeping the old park benches for future use.

Putting parking limit signs on city parking behind Pearl Street was discussed. The ordinance will need to be updated to include this space. Cars are being repaired and not moving.

Water shut offs were discussed. Letters to be drawn up and attach to taxes as payments are not being made.

Vogt motioned to set a public hearing for the property tax levy at the April 7<sup>th</sup> meeting. Another separate meeting will be held after the meeting for the hearing. Reeves seconded. A roll call vote was taken, all ayes.

The VJ Engineering consultant agreement was reviewed.

Vogt motioned to adjourn, seconded by Reeves. All ayes.
