6-18-2024 a regular meeting of the Shellsburg City Council was called to order by Mayor Travis at 6:00pm in the Council Chambers. Roll call was answered by Harvey, Hepker, Travis, Reeves. Vogt was absent.

Harvey motioned to approve the consent agenda, seconded by Hepker. All ayes.

Harvey motioned to approve the April Treasurer's Report, seconded by Travis. All ayes.

Travis motioned to approve the April revenues, seconded by Hepker. All ayes.

The April revenues were as follows: General \$118,956.90; Library \$5,111.99; Rec Dept \$3,950.00; Big Day \$700.00; RUT \$11,371.54; Employee Benefits \$14,449.36; Emergency Fund \$3,402.17; LOST \$7,496.56; TIF \$17,688.94; Debt Service \$34,590.51; Capital Projects \$10,130.30; Water \$12,752.91; Sewer \$25,569.35; Garbage \$11,108.84. Public Forum: Wilda Solberg requested water on and open bathrooms for Family Fun Night 6-27-2024 6:30-8:00pm.

Council Forum: Scott Hepker asked for SACG if they could reserve the park for 10 weeks on Wednesdays for the Farmer's Market. There was discussion on closing Harbert Street on July 4<sup>th</sup> at 6:00pm to parking. Open to spectators but too many cars to park on the street. The SUDAS Ordinance #481 was reviewed and discussed. Two changes need to be made then will have the 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> readings.

The city Facebook admin privileges were discussed and should be council members or city employees. Reeves motioned to have clerk and mayor administrators, seconded by Hepker. A roll call vote was taken. All ayes. Vogt absent.

Harvey motioned to approve Resolution #06-18-2024, setting the date for a public hearing on designation of the 2024 Shellsburg Housing Urban Renewal Area. Travis seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken, all ayes. Vogt was absent.

The resident complaint was discussed. An attorney might need to help resolve.

Hepker motioned to approve the 1<sup>st</sup> reading of Ordinance #479, seconded by Travis. All ayes. Vogt was absent. The 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> readings were waived. Travis motioned to adopt Ordinance #479, updating water rates, seconded by Reeves. All ayes. Vogt was absent.

Hepker motioned to approve the first reading of Ordinance #480, updating sewer rates. Reeves seconded. All ayes. Vogt was absent. The 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> readings were waived. Harvey motioned to adopt Ordinance #480, seconded by Reeves. All ayes. Vogt was absent.
